Welcome to the Phil Price Memorial Woodpecker Rally supported for a second year by the Phil Price Rally School and Presteigne Tyre Services, celebrating the life of Phil Price, who set up and ran the Phil Price Rally School for 30 years until his untimely death in 2020.

The Woodpecker Rally will have a fresh new look in 2023 as it continues its theme of progression and diversification by revamping the entire route of the rally and utilising little-used forests on both sides of the Welsh and English borders.

As one of the most popular events on the British rallying calendar, many of the popular features have been retained, including its traditional Ludlow Racecourse base and eight special stages. But a radical shakeup in the route will see some new tests included on the roster, bolstered by the return of forests not used for decades by the rally.

Stages such as Cwmysgawen, just west of Knighton in Powys and Ceri, situated just outside of Newtown, will feature in 2023. But the rally will also retain its highly popular double run through Haye Park, just outside of Ludlow. Traditionally attracting many spectators from the town and surrounding areas, the blast through the forest on the English side of the border provides a fitting climax to the event before the return to the racecourse for the champagne spray finish celebrations.

We are very pleased to welcome for the second time the Motorsport UK Fuchs Lubricants British Historic Rally Championship along with long time Woodpecker supporters, the MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally Series, the Motorsport UK Pirelli Welsh Rally Championship, the Motorsport UK English Rally Championship, the IPS Paints Rally Challenge, the ANWCC Forest Stage Rally Championship and the West Wales Rally Spares HRCR Stage Masters Rally Challenge.

We will again be running ALL 2WD cars first on the road in reverse seeded order followed by all 4WD cars seeded normally.

Ludlow Racecourse will be the location for all pre and post event activities and for servicing between the stages, as well as the awards presentation and champagne spray.

We would kindly ask you to listen to the instructions of the marshals, stand only where it is safe to do so and please do not endanger you or others whilst the special stage is live. We hope you enjoy your day, it's sure to be action packed!

Remember, a good rally, is a SAFE RALLY.

- The marshals are all volunteers and are also very professional. Please respect them and their requests in order to ensure that we all have a safe and enjoyable rally.




#### SPECTATOR VIEWING AREAS


are defined by BLACK AND YELLOW TAPE

Spectator parking will be on the opposite side of the public highway to the stage so care should be taken crossing the road. 


